3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Establish penalty for failure to produce a concealed handgun permit upon demand of a law-enforcement officer.

5. Summary: This bill provides a civil penalty of \$25 for carrying a concealed handgun and failing to produce a concealed handgun permit and a government-issued photo identification when requested by a law-enforcement officer. However, a court may waive this penalty if the person presents a valid concealed handgun permit and government-issued photo identification to the court.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate (see Section 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how many violations could result from this proposed legislation. However, any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
