**4. Title:** **Eliminating requirement for HPV vaccine**

**5. Summary:** Eliminates the requirement of the human papillomavirus vaccine (HPV) for females.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** None.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Virginia Department of Health

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** The bill removes the requirement that girls entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade receive the first dose of the HPV vaccine. This requirement was passed during the 2007 General Assembly session and became enacted on October 1, 2008. HB 686 would not impact funding the Virginia Department of Health receives for the purchase of HPV vaccines. The Virginia Department of Health is still required to provide the vaccine to eligible children who cannot afford to receive the vaccine through private insurance.
