Summary:** The proposed legislation would require the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) to evaluate and make annual reports on significant transportation improvement projects in the Northern Virginia highway construction district.

- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would require the reports to evaluate the transportation projects by the total amount of traffic congestion reduced by the project and the traffic reduction the project achieved per dollar spent. Such evaluations are to be determined using transportation modeling software. VDOT would hire outside consultants to conduct the evaluations. The costs associated procuring and managing consultants would require VDOT and DRPT to shift funds from other priorities.
