**4. Title:** Public sewer system; civil penalty for violation of local ordinances.

**5. Summary:** This bill allows any locality under an order of the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality issued pursuant to the authority of subdivision (8a) of § 62.1-44.15 to adopt an ordinance establishing a uniform schedule of civil penalties for violations of ordinances governing the introduction of pollutants and wastes into the locality's public sewer system. Such civil penalties may not be more than \$100 for the initial summons and not more than \$150 for each additional summons.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No fiscal impact for the Department of Environmental Quality. There is a potential for local government revenue.
