- 5. Summary/Purpose: To prohibit a foreign corporation, limited liability company, business trust, limited partnership, or registered limited liability partnership from bidding on, or entering into, amending, or renewing, a contract with a public body under the Virginia Public Procurement Act unless the foreign entity provides a copy of a valid certificate of authority or registration to conduct business in the Commonwealth. Such status shall be maintained during the term of a contract and for five years after its term is completed. A contract entered into by a business in violation of the requirements is voidable at the option of the public body.
- 6. Fiscal impact estimates are minimal.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal implications:** Requiring all public bodies to obtain a copy of a valid certificate issued by the State Corporation Commission from a vendor before accepting a bid, issuing an award, amending or renewing a contract may result in an additional administrative costs to agencies and institutions governed by the Virginia Public Procurement Act.

Revenue impact to the Commonwealth is indeterminate if foreign corporations are be subject to required registrations charged through the State Corporation Commission in this legislation.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: This bill will impact all public bodies except Level III (VT, UVA, W&M, and VCU) and Level II (RU, VMI, JMU, GMU, LU and ODU) institutions operating under Management Agreements and Memorandums of Understanding.
