4. Title: **Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act; Social security account numbers.**

5. Summary: The bill clarifies that a government entity cannot require an individual to furnish his entire social security number or any portion thereof. The bill also clarifies that a social security number or any portion thereof cannot be displayed on a student or government identification card.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The impacts are indeterminate as there may be state agency applications or systems that currently display a portion of the social security number and will require modification to follow these new requirements in the production of identification cards, license certificates, or mailing labels.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Any state agencies that are required to process social security numbers.
