4. Title: **Route 711; Buchanan County may enter into an agreement with Pike County, Kentucky, to improve.**

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would authorize Buchanan County to enter into an agreement with Pike County, Kentucky, to improve Route 711. The bill would allow Buchanan County to use coal and gas road improvement funds to pay for land acquisition and improvement costs. The Virginia Department of Transportation is to maintain any improvements to the roadway.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would allow Buchanan County to use coal and gas road improvement funds to improve Route 711. Maintenance on the improved Route 711 can be absorbed within the Department of Transportation's existing resources.
