4. Title Virginia Retirement System; creditable compensation of teachers.

5. Summary/Purpose: Virginia Retirement System; creditable compensation of teachers.
 Provides that the creditable compensation of teachers for retirement purposes under the Virginia Retirement System shall include all compensation payable to teachers by their public school boards, including compensation that is not pursuant to a contract for teaching. Such additional compensation would include pay for coaching athletics and participating in other after-school activities.

- 7. Budget amendment necessary:** Yes. The cost of this legislation will be reflected in increased employer contribution rates for FY11. This measure would also increase the unfunded liability by \$289,149,000 which will decrease the funded ratio of the teacher plan.
- 8. Fiscal implications:** According to the Virginia Department of Education, approximately \$119 million in supplemental payments are made to teachers above and beyond their annual contract salaries. Although this bill applies only to additional pay earned by school teachers, it creates a precedent for additional pay earned by all members of the system, including overtime pay.
