4. Title: Retention of copies of voter changes of address.

5. Summary: Provides that a general registrar for the locality where a voter formerly resided shall retain copies of documentation, received as part of a registration application or otherwise, and shall be sent copies of such documents if they were originally provided to a different registrar indicating that the voter's residence has changed.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill codifies existing requirement to retain copies relating to transfers of voters within Virginia.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: State Board of Elections, local government
