- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes, Item 136, SB 30, to provide start-up costs and to account for associated savings and position addition.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: Savings in operations and maintenance are realized with in house technology service in the long term. Technology equipment and installation fees result in one-time cost in the first year. While savings are indicated, the agency would be charged for necessary statewide services (such as email) that can only be provided by the Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA). Services and associated costs can be determined by VITA, but are not included in fiscal impact estimates.

One technology support position is required to provide in house support, as well.

Methodology:

One-time start up costs (FY 2011):

Replacement of computers and printers = \$200,000 Replacement of servers = \$75,000 Replacement of switches, fibers, and routers = \$315,000 Installation fees = \$20,000 Total = \$610,000 one-time start up costs

Current annual general fund technology costs (VITA services) = \$535,000 (approximate)

Projected annual technology costs (in-house)

Microsoft software license = \$35,000 Anti-virus license = \$35,000 Equipment replacement = \$75,000 <u>Personnel = \$66,000 (\$50,000 salary, \$16,000 benefits)</u> Annual technology cost = \$211,000

Current technology costs (\$535,000) – projected in house costs (\$211,000) = \$324,000 general fund annual savings
