- **8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill permanently establishes the P-16 advisory council. The Council shall be composed of 21 members representing the General Assembly, citizens, the Secretary of Education, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the President of the Board of Education, the Executive Director of the State Council of Higher Education (SCHEV), the Chairman of SCHEV, and the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College.

The P-16 Council was initially funded through a National Governor's Association Honors States grant in 2005. In the prior year, support for the Council has been provided through the Secretary of Education's office. The introduced budget anticipated that the Secretary of Education's office would continue support at an annual estimated cost of \$10,000.
