**4. Title:**        **Voluntary admission for mental health treatment prior to involuntary commitment hearing**

**5. Summary:** Voluntary admission for mental health treatment prior to involuntary commitment hearing; Provides that a person may be voluntarily admitted to a facility for mental health treatment after issuance of a temporary detention order but before a hearing for involuntary commitment by the persons attending or consulting physician where the physician finds that the person is will and able to volunteer for treatment and after the person is informed that they will be required to provide 48 hours notice prior to leaving the facility to which they are voluntarily admitted and will be prohibited from owning, possessing, or transporting a firearm.
