6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 4.1-306 of the Code of Virginia, relating to providing alcohol to
7	underage persons; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 4.1-306 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 4.1-306. Purchasing alcoholic beverages for one to whom they may not be sold; penalty; forfeiture.
11	A. Any person who purchases alcoholic beverages for another person, and at the time of such
12	purchase knows or has reason to believe that the person for whom the alcoholic beverage was purchased
13	was (i) interdicted, or (ii) intoxicated, is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
14	A1. Any person who purchases for, or otherwise gives, provides, or assists in the provision of
15	alcoholic beverages to another person, knowing when he knows or has reason to know that such person
16	was less than 21 years of age, except (i) pursuant to subdivisions 1 through 7 of § 4.1-200; (ii) where
17	possession of the alcoholic beverages by a person less than 21 years of age is due to such person's
18	making a delivery of alcoholic beverages in pursuance of his employment or an order of his parent; or
19	(iii) by any state, federal, or local law-enforcement officer when possession of an alcoholic beverage is
20	necessary in the performance of his duties, is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
21	B. In addition to any other penalty authorized by law, any person found guilty of a violation of this
22	section shall have his license to operate a motor vehicle suspended for a period of not more than one
22	waar. The court in its discretion may authorize any person convicted of a violation of this section the
