10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. Special license plates marking the bicentennial of the American War of 1812; fees.
12	A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner
13 14	of the Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue to the applicant special license plates marking the bicentennial of the American War of 1812.
14	B. For each set of license plates issued pursuant to this act, the Commissioner shall charge, in
15 16	addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$15 at the time the plates are
17	issued. For each such \$15 fee collected, \$5 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a
18	special nonreverting fund known as the Virginia Bicentennial of the American War of 1812 Fund
19	established within the Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Virginia
20	Bicentennial of the American War of 1812 Commission and used to support its operation and programs
$\overline{21}$	in Virginia. All other fees imposed under the provisions of this section shall be paid to, and received by,
22	the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and paid by him into the state treasury and set
23	aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by the Department of Motor
24	Vehicles.
