10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 51.1-142.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 51.1-142.3. Purchase of additional prior service credit by certain school division superintendents.
13 14	A. In addition to the four years of prior service credit that may be purchased under clause (ii) of subdivision $\mathbb{R}_{1}$ of $\$$ 51.1.142.2, a school division superintendent appointed by a school heard pursuant
14	subdivision B 1 of § 51.1-142.2, a school division superintendent appointed by a school board pursuant to § 22.1-60, with at least five years of creditable service in the Retirement System, may purchase up to
16	a maximum of 10 additional years of prior service credit for creditable service of another state or of a
17	political subdivision, or public school system of this or another state, as certified by such state, political
18	subdivision, or public school system. Except as otherwise required by Chapter 1223 of Title 10 of the
19	United States Code, the service credit made available under this section may not be purchased if, before
20	being purchased or at the time of such purchase pursuant to this section, the service to be purchased is
21	service that is included in the calculation of any retirement allowance received or to be received by the
22	member from this or any other retirement system.
23 24	The school board that has appointed such school division superintendent may purchase such prior service credit on behalf of the school division superintendent.
24 25	B. The cost at the time of purchase for each additional year of service credit (or portion thereof)
23 26	pursuant to this section, shall be 10 percent of the school division superintendent's creditable
27	compensation or 10 percent of the school division superintendent's average final compensation,
28	whichever is greater, provided that the service credit to be purchased is paid for in one lump-sum
29	payment within one year after the school division superintendent first became eligible to purchase such
30	service credit or by July 1, 2004, whichever is later.
31	A school division superintendent shall first become eligible to purchase prior service credit under this
32 33	section as follows:
33 34	1. For members in service on June 30, 2003, and July 1, 2003, upon attaining five years of creditable service as a school division superintendent in the Retirement System;
35	2. For members in service on June 30, 2003, and July 1, 2003, who become a school division
36	superintendent on or after July 1, 2003, upon attaining five years of creditable service as a school
37	division superintendent in the Retirement System; and
38	3. For members not in service on June 30, 2003, upon the member earning five years of creditable
39	service as a school division superintendent in the Retirement System for service performed after June

41 42	C. In any case in which prior service credit pursuant to this section has been purchased by or on
42 43	behalf of a school division superintendent, if the school division superintendent, subsequent to the date of such purchase, does not remain in such position with the local school board for at least the number
<b>4</b> 4	of years purchased: (i) the Retirement System shall reduce the creditable service credited to the school
45	division superintendent by an amount equivalent to the number of years of prior service purchased less
46	the number of years served by the person as a school division superintendent with the local school
47	board subsequent to the date of such purchase. Such reduction in creditable service shall be deemed to
48	be forfeited by the school division superintendent for purposes of this chapter and the contributions
<b>49</b>	representing that forfeited service shall be refunded to the school division superintendent; and (ii) the

55	subsection A within the timeframe provided in subsection B, such prior service credit may be purchased
56	at the actuarial equivalent cost, provided that in no case shall any person purchase more than 10 years
57	of such prior service credit under this section.
