

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-733 of the Code of Virginia, relating to license plates for persons*  
3 *delivering unladen vehicles.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-733 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-733. License plates for persons delivering unladen vehicles; fees.

9 A. On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue appropriately designed license plates to  
10 persons engaged in the business of delivering unladen motor vehicles under their own power from points  
11 of assembly or distribution.

12 B. Every applicant for license plates to be issued under this section shall, before he begins delivery  
13 of any of these vehicles, apply to the Commissioner for a registration card and license plates. On the  
14 payment of a fee of \$75, a registration card and license plates shall be issued to the applicant in a form  
15 prescribed by the Commissioner. The Commissioner shall issue to the applicant two license plates. For  
16 each additional license plate, a fee of \$20 per plate shall be paid by the applicant.

17 C. It shall be unlawful for any person to use these license plates other than on unladen motor  
18 vehicles, trailers, and semitrailers which are being delivered from points of assembly or distribution in  
19 the usual course of his delivery business or which are used as provided in subsection D of this section.  
20 The operators of such vehicles being delivered, bearing license plates issued under this section, shall at  
21 all times during their operation have in their possession a proper bill of lading showing the point of  
22 origin and destination of the vehicle being delivered and describing it. *It shall be unlawful for any*  
23 *person to use these license plates unless either the origin or the destination of the vehicle being*  
24 *delivered is within the Commonwealth.*

25 D. License plates issued under this section may be used by any financial institutions specifically  
26 excluded from the definition of "motor vehicle dealer" in subdivision 5 of § 46.2-1500 for the purpose  
27 of using them in the normal course of business in taking, repossessing, or otherwise transporting  
28 vehicles for the purpose of preservation, sale, allowing a prospective buyer to test-drive the vehicle if  
29 the prospective buyer is accompanied by an employee of the financial institution or has the written  
30 permission of the financial institution on a form provided by the Department, or otherwise in connection  
31 with repossession or foreclosure of the vehicle on which there is a security interest securing a loan to a  
32 financial institution.

33 E. License plates issued under this section may be issued to any business engaged in *automobile*  
34 *auctions or* the mounting, installing, servicing, or repairing of equipment on or in a vehicle. The use of  
35 license plates issued under this section shall be limited to (i) the pick-up and delivery of a vehicle or (ii)  
36 *driving on the highway in order to test the installation, service, or repairs at a distance of not more*  
37 *than five miles from the place of business* and shall not be used on vehicles employed for general  
38 transportation.
