That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 1 of Title 22.1 a section numbered **22.1-7.1** as follows: 10 § 22.1-7.1. Open school enrollment policy. 11 A. Any local school board may establish and implement policies to provide for the open enrollment 12 to any school of any student residing within the school division upon the request of a parent or 13 14 guardian. In developing such policies, a local school board may consider the inclusion of the following 15 conditions and limitations: 16 1. An application process whereby parents or guardians indicate a school preference for purposes of 17 their child attending a school in the school division outside of the attendance area in which they reside; 18 2. A requirement that the parent or guardian provide transportation for the student attending a 19 school other than his assigned school; 20 3. A requirement that a student may be disqualified from attending a school other than his assigned 21 school if he has been subject to a specified disciplinary action; 22 4. A prohibition on the recruitment of a student from one school to another by a school division 23 employee; 24 5. A limitation on participation in certain athletic activities for a student who chooses to attend a 25 school other than his assigned school; 26 6. A random, unbiased selection process in the event open enrollment requests exceed the capacity of 27 a school: 28 7. A provision that a student shall be permitted to remain at the receiving school until the student 29 has completed the highest grade in the school; and 30 8. A preference to a student (i) who resides in a location that has been subject to a change in school 31 attendance area during the previous two years, (ii) who has a sibling attending the receiving school, or 32 (iii) whose parent or guardian is an employee of the receiving school. 33 B. A copy of the division policies for open enrollment, if any, shall be posted on the division's 34 website and shall be available to the public upon request. 35 C. Nothing in this section shall interfere with a local school division's authority to adopt a pupil 36 placement plan pursuant to § 22.1-79. D. For the purposes of this section, "open enrollment" means a policy adopted and implemented by a 37 38 local school board to allow students to enroll in any school within the school division of attendance 39 regardless of the location of their residence.

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
