A BILL to direct the Disability Commission to study continued access to assistive technology for students.

10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

§ 1. That the Disability Commission shall convene a work group to study continued access to 11 1. assistive technology customized for students throughout the educational process and upon graduation 12 from or aging out of secondary education. The work group shall include representatives of the 13 Department of Rehabilitative Services, the Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired, the 14 15 Department for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, the Department of Education, local school divisions, the 16 Assistive Technology Loan Fund, and such other persons as the Disability Commission shall deem appropriate. In conducting its study, the work group shall (i) determine how assistive technology 17 accompanies students through transitions in the educational process, including transitions between 18 grades, between schools within the same system, between schools in different school systems, and 19 20 between school and postsecondary education or employment; (ii) identify barriers to continued access to 21 assistive technology devices customized for students between grades, schools, and school divisions and 22 following a student's graduation from or aging out of secondary education; (iii) identify and evaluate 23 policy options for enabling continued access to assistive technology devices customized for students, 24 including options for allowing students to purchase or otherwise take ownership of devices following 25 graduation or upon aging out of secondary education; and (iv) develop recommendations for policies to facilitate continued access to assistive technology devices customized for students across settings. The 26 27 work group shall report to the Disability Commission no later than September 15, 2011.
