## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 8.01-385 of the Code of Virginia, relating to definitions for statutory 3 rules of evidence in civil actions.

#### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

#### 7 1. That § 8.01-385 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 8.01-385. Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

10 1. The term "United States" shall be deemed to refer to the United States of America and to include any of its territories, commonwealths, insular possessions, the District of Columbia, and any of its other 11 12 political subdivisions other than states.

2. The term "court" shall be deemed to include the courts of this Commonwealth, any other person 13 14 or body appointed by it or acting under its process or authority in a judicial or quasi-judicial capacity, 15 and any other judicial, quasi-judicial, or fact-finding body acting pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth, including without limitation, the State Corporation Commission and the Virginia 16 17 Workers' Compensation Commission.

18 3. The term "political subdivision" shall: (i) as applied to the United States, include any other 19 political subdivision other than states and including without limitation the District of Columbia and the 20 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; (ii) as applied to other countries, include without limitation states, 21 counties, cities, towns, boroughs, and any division thereof recognized and vested with the authority to 22 enact or promulgate ordinances, rules, and regulations having the force or effect of law; (iii) as applied 23 to this Commonwealth and other states of the United States, include without limitation counties, cities, 24 towns, boroughs, and any other division thereof recognized and vested with the authority to enact or 25 promulgate ordinances, rules, and regulations having the force or effect of law.

26 4. The term "agency" shall be deemed to include without limitation any department, division, 27 commission, association, board, or other administrative body established pursuant to the laws of a 28 jurisdiction.

29 5. The term "official publication" includes any registry or listing of licenses, permits, or registrations 30 posted on the official website of an agency or political subdivision.

6. The term "publish" includes posting by an agency or political subdivision on its official website. 31

32 7. The term "required to be published pursuant to the laws thereof" includes being subject to 33 disclosure under § 54.1-108.
