That §§ 2.2-1517 and 2.2-1518 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 2.2-1517. Agency submission of information. 11 A. In addition to all other reporting requirements imposed upon state agencies and public educational 12 13 institutions provided under law, state agencies and public educational institutions shall submit to the Advisory Committee information requested as determined by the Advisory Committee in the format and 14 on the schedule established by the Advisory Committee for the initial development of the capital outlay 15 project list as described in § 2.2-1516, as well as for the annual modifications to the six-year capital 16 outlay plan described in § 2.2-1518. The information for the annual modifications shall include, but not 17 18 be limited to, changes in cost estimates. 19 B. On or before January 30 each year, the Director of the Department of General Services, on 20 behalf of the Advisory Committee, shall advise state agencies and public educational institutions of the 21 content, format, and method established by the Advisory Committee for submitting the information 22 described in subsection A. 23 C. State agencies and public educational institutions shall submit the information, in the manner 24 prescribed by the Director of the Department of General Services on behalf of the Advisory Committee 25 pursuant to subsection B, to the Department of General Services and the Department of Planning and Budget on or before March 30 each year. In addition, public educational institutions shall submit the 26 27 information to the State Council of Higher Education. 28 D. The Department of Planning and Budget, the Department of General Services, and the [ staff of 29 the ] State Council of Higher Education shall review the information submitted and shall submit the 30 information and the results of their review, in the manner prescribed by the Advisory Committee, to the 31 Advisory Committee on or before June 30 each year. E. On the same day that the Governor [ reports his reestimate of general fund revenues pursuant to 32 33 \$ 2.2-1503.3, the Advisory Committee shall meet at a time and place specified by the Director of the 34 Department of General Services presents his preliminary report pursuant to § 2.2-813, the Advisory Committee shall meet at a time and place specified by the Secretary of Finance ] to consider the 35 36 information provided pursuant to subsection D, as well as a capital outlay project status report, to be 37 prepared by the Director of the Department of General Services, on all active projects that have 38 received any funding, including completed planning estimates, project bids, and project timelines. The 39 Advisory Committee shall submit its evaluations and recommendations regarding capital outlay projects 40 to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before November 1 each year. 41 § 2.2-1518. Governor to submit a tentative bill for a capital outlay plan; gubernatorial amendments 42 proposed to the plan. A. 1. No later than January 13, 2009, the Governor shall submit to the General Assembly a tentative 43 44 bill establishing a capital outlay plan that includes new capital outlay projects (and previously planned 45 or authorized capital outlay projects) that the Governor proposes to be funded entirely or partially from general fund-supported resources for the six fiscal years beginning July 1, 2009. Projects included in the 46 47 capital outlay plan shall be in addition to any projects for which funds are appropriated from the Central Maintenance Reserve of the general appropriation act. 48 49 2. The capital outlay plan submitted by the Governor shall list capital outlay projects in different 50 tiers. Each tier shall be a grouping of capital outlay projects with the total estimated cost of each project 51 in the tier falling within a minimum and a maximum project cost assigned to the tier, provided that no 52 estimated project costs shall be set out in the plan. The minimum and maximum range assigned to a tier 53 shall be mutually exclusive of all other minimum and maximum ranges assigned to other tiers in order 54 that no capital outlay project shall be reported in more than one tier. For each capital outlay project listed in the plan the Governor shall provide the following information: (i) the agency or public educational institution to which the project is related, (ii) a 55 56 57 description of the project, and (iii) a ranking number assigned to the project, which number shall signify 58 the priority of the project when compared to all other projects of the agency or institution listed in the

**59** plan.

B. In 2010 2011, and each year thereafter, the Governor shall, by no later than the day that immediately precedes the first day of the regular session of the applicable General Assembly on or before December 20, submit to the General Assembly a tentative bill proposing amendments to the current capital outlay plan enacted into law, including adjusting the fiscal years covered by the plan so that the plan will cover the six fiscal years beginning on the immediately following July 1. Any such tentative bill shall be submitted using the format described in subsection A.

66 C. In submitting to the General Assembly tentative bills for the initial capital outlay plan and for 67 plan amendments, the Governor shall consider the capital outlay project list submitted by the Advisory

68 Committee pursuant to § 2.2-1516 and any amendments to the six-year capital outlay plan recommended

69 by the Advisory Committee pursuant to such section.
