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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 32.1-102.3:5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 32.1-102.3:5. Relocation of certain nursing home beds under limited circumstances.
13	A. Notwithstanding (i) the provisions of §§ 32.1-102.3 and 32.1-102.3:2, (ii) any regulations of the
14	Board establishing standards for the approval and issuance of Requests for Applications, and (iii) the
15	provisions of any current Requests for Applications issued by the Commissioner pursuant to
16	§ 32.1-102.3:2, the Commissioner shall accept applications and may issue certificates of public need for
17	nursing home beds when such beds are a relocation from one facility to another facility under common
18	ownership or control, regardless of whether they are in the same planning district, if, as of December 31
19	of the year preceding the year in which relocation is proposed, the following criteria are met:
20	1. The occupancy rate of the facility seeking to relocate beds, based upon the total number of beds
21	for which the facility is licensed, was less than 67% 67 percent;
22	2. Greater than 25% 25 percent of the residents of the facility from which beds are to be relocated,
23	immediately prior to moving to the facility, resided outside the planning district in which the facility is
24	located; and
25	3. Any facility to which beds are to be relocated has experienced an average occupancy rate that
26	meets or exceeds 90% 90 percent.
27	B. A relocation of nursing home beds under the circumstances described herein shall not constitute a
28	"project" as defined in § 32.1-102.1. An entity may not relocate more than two-thirds of the total
29	number of beds for which the facility was licensed prior to any relocation pursuant to this section. In
30	addition, any entity that has relocated beds pursuant to this section and thereafter given the
31	Commissioner notice of its intention to close the facility may, within 36 months of such closure, relocate
32	the remaining beds to another facility, either existing or new, under common ownership or control,
33	without regard to the criteria set forth in this section, and the Commissioner shall accept the
34	application and may issue a certificate of public need for such relocation. Any restrictions that apply to
35	the certificate at the time of the relocation shall remain in effect following the relocation.

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
