| 11 | 1. § 1. That a government agency shall not require any charitable organization to: |
| 12 | 1. Disclose individual demographic information concerning employees, officers, directors, trustees, |
| 13 | members, or owners, without the prior written consent of such individuals; |
| 14 | 2. Disclose individual demographic information concerning any person, or the employees, officers, |
| 15 | directors, trustees, members or owners of any entity that has received monetary or in-kind contributions |
| 16 | for or contracted with a charitable organization without the prior written consent of such individuals; |
| 17 18 | 3. Include in the membership of the governing board or officers of the charitable organization an individual based on his demographic characteristics; |
| 19 | 4. Prohibit an individual from serving as a board member or officer based upon the individual's |
| 20 | familial relationship to other board members or officers or to a donor; |
| 21 | 5. Include in the membership of the governing board or one or more individuals who do not share a |
