17 18	supports that best meet their preferences and needs; and WHEREAS, Real Choice Systems Change Grants: Systems Transformation, Money Follows the
10 19	Person, Community Living Program and Options Counseling Grants were awarded to Virginia and other
20	states committed to building an infrastructure to strengthen long-term community supports; and
21	WHEREAS, Virginia has demonstrated its commitment to building a strong community infrastructure
22	of person-centered long-term supports through all of these grants in order to transform the long-term
23	support system in the Commonwealth; and
24	WHEREAS, multiple state and local agencies have been actively working to encourage the use of
25	person-centered practices to honor each individual's own choices; and
26	WHEREAS, multiple state agencies have adopted or are in the process of adopting person-centered
27	principles and language in agency regulations, policies, and procedures and are implementing
28 29	person-centered practices in their support of individuals who use their services; now, therefore, be it
