20 WHEREAS, a woman of faith, Mary Jones was a lifetime member of Piney Grove A.M.E. Zion 21 Church in Waverly, where she enjoyed fellowship, worship, and service that greatly enriched her life; 22 and

25 WHEREAS, Mary Jones will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by her three brothers, Waverly, Bernard, and Cecil, and their families; her other family members and many friends; and the 26 27 residents of Sussex County; now, therefore, be it
