**4. Title:**    Immigration laws; State Police to enter into agreement with U.S. Immigration & Customs Enforcement.

**5. Summary:** Provides that the Superintendent of State Police shall seek to enter into a memorandum of agreement with Immigration and Customs Enforcement that would allow the State Police to perform certain federal immigration law-enforcement functions in the Commonwealth. Such an agreement is often referred to as an agreement under the federal 287(g) program.
