8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation would have no fiscal impact. It would require the Department of Motor Vehicles to accept birth registration cards issued by the Office of Vital Records as proof of birth in the United States, and thus as proof of U.S. citizenship. The agency believes that § 32.1-272 of the *Code of Virginia* already imposes this requirement; hence DMV already accepts birth registration cards as proof of citizenship.
