Fiscal Implications:** The enactment of this bill will increase the demand for voter registration applications, thereby resulting in increased expenditures for State Board of Elections (SBE), associated with the printing and distribution of said applications. The State Board of Elections SBE estimates an annual implementation cost of \$5,000. Additional printing costs associated would approximate \$1,000 whereas shipping costs would total approximately \$3,900. There should be only a minimal impact to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF)
