4. Title: General registrar; appointment by electoral board.

5. Summary: General registrar; qualifications. Allows an electoral board to appoint a general registrar who is a qualified voter of a county or city adjoining the jurisdiction for which he is appointed.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no material fiscal impact

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill should not have any direct fiscal impact on the State Board of Elections (SBE). The current residency requirement tends to increase recruitment costs by requiring assistance with relocation expenses or approving a higher salary rate to make accepting a position economically feasible. The bill may also result in an increased candidate pool, thus driving down salary requirements.
