**5. Summary:** Elections; local electoral boards; certain prohibitions. Prohibits a member of a local electoral board from being the spouse or other relative of a candidate for or holder of an office filled in whole or in part by voters in the jurisdiction of the electoral board.

Fiscal Implications:** The enactment of this bill would require some operational modifications on the part of State Board of Elections, i.e. educating the electoral boards, political parties and the general public of the new eligibility restrictions, and some modification to the Certificate of Eligibility form.
