5. Summary: This bill clarifies that the number of employees assigned to the processing of benefit claims shall be sufficient to maintain a ratio of one staff person for every 26,212 veterans residing in the Commonwealth.

Fiscal Implications: In order bring claims staffing to the mandated ratio of one staff person for every 26,212 veterans, the Department of Veterans Services requires funding for four existing claims agent positions. The impact also includes additional rent costs of \$30,000 annually and a one-time cost of \$10,000 for equipment and furniture in FY 2012.
