5. Summary: The bill provides that the provisions of § 2.2-3803 (denying the right of a government agency to require the disclosure of a social security number) shall not apply to the Code provisions that provide for issuance of an Identity Theft Passport.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill merely excludes the provisions in § 2.2-3803 and this exclusion does not present cause for increased or decreased costs to the Commonwealth.
