11. Other Comments: The bill clarifies that only persons who participate in the VSDP are eligible for the employer paid long-term care coverage provided by the program. Further, the legislation clarifies that a participant, who leaves employment and is no longer covered under the Virginia Sickness and Disability program, may purchase, at his or her own expense, continuing coverage of his Long Term Care insurance.
