**4. Title:** Child care services; reimbursement rates

**5. Summary:** This legislation directs the Department of Social Services to identify strategies that will increase child care services reimbursement rates for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) recipients and families whose incomes are at or below 185 percent of the federal poverty level. These strategies should increase rates to an amount comparable to the goal identified by the United States Department of Health and Human Services. In addition, the bill directs the department to develop criteria for determining an appropriate local match for funds available for child care services for such TANF recipients and families.
