2. Patron: Anderson

3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Voter registration; certain overseas voters.

5. Summary: Changes the duration of a temporary voter registration for certain overseas voters from the end of the federal election cycle or 365 days to either the next November general election or federal general election, whichever is later. The bill also requires absentee ballots to be available 45 days prior to the election or three business days after receipt of the completed application, whichever is later; and makes other technical changes.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal, see Item 8

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) does not foresee a significant fiscal impact by the passage of this bill. However, the agency will incur annual training costs for absentee voting, estimated at \$6,300 per year. This can be incorporated within the agency's current training program.
