8.	Fiscal Implications: This bill is not anticipated to have any fiscal impact on the state. The bill permits the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) to operate golf carts or utility vehicles on portions of public highways located within DCR property and on Virginia Department of Transportation- (VDOT) maintained highways that are adjacent to DCR

Current law prohibits use of golf carts and utility vehicles on most roads within or adjacent to DCR-operated state parks, as these roads are part of the VDOT-maintained secondary road system. This bill would permit DCR staff to operate golf carts and utility vehicles for duties necessary to the operations of the state park system.
