3. Committee: House Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Virginia National Guard; failure to report.

5. Summary: Amends the section of the Code of Virginia addressing a member of the Virginia National Guard's failure to report for duty. Failure to report would be a Class 4 misdemeanor; the bill allows any officer of the missing soldier or airman's unit to swear out a warrant.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation has no material fiscal impact on the Department of Military Affairs, the Virginia National Guard nor the Courts system. If adopted, this legislation makes failure to report to duty a Class 4 misdemeanor, punishable up to a \$250 fine. Any fines collected would be deposited to the Literary Fund.
