4. Title: The Road to Revolution.

5. Summary: This bill adds Leatherwood Plantation in Henry County to this heritage trail of sites significant to Patrick Henry.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill adds a location to “The Road to Revolution,” the heritage trail of sites significant to Patrick Henry. According to the bill, if requested by the entity with custodial responsibilities of the site, the Department of Transportation is to erect an identifying sign in the right-of-way of this additional site. Also according to the bill, all costs associated with the manufacturing, erection and maintenance of this sign, estimated by VDOT to be approximately \$3,000 the first year and \$500 each year thereafter, are to be borne by the requesting party. Accordingly, there are no costs to be absorbed by VDOT resulting from this bill.

The Department of Historic Resources does not anticipate any fiscal impact on the agency resulting from this bill.
