4. Title: Operation of all-terrain vehicles

5. Summary:

Generally, state law prohibits the operation of all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) on public roads. Exempted from the prohibition are specified portions of public roads in Buchanan County, over which ATVs may be operated if approved by the county Board of Supervisors and subject to several conditions. The proposed legislation would also exempt specified portions of several public roads in Tazewell County, subject to the same conditions.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. No Fiscal Impact. Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications:

One of the conditions required for the operation of ATVs on public roads is the erection of signs warning motorists that ATVs may be operating on the highway. The statute requires that these signs be paid for by the person or club requesting approval to operate the ATVs on the highways. Therefore, the bill will not have a fiscal impact on any state agency.
