4. Title: A BILL to amend and reenact the first enactment of Chapter 687 of the Acts of Assembly of 2008, relating to the "Wilderness Road: Virginia's Heritage Migration Route."

5. Summary/Purpose:

Designates the highway segments composing the Wilderness Road as Virginia byways.

6. Fiscal Impacts are unavailable

Fiscal implications: If this legislation passes, VDOT's cost to fabricate and install Virginia Byway designation signage would be dependent on factors such as the number of locations required and the type of installation required. VDOT estimates the cost of erecting such signs to be \$850 per sign, with an estimated \$106,250 in installation expenses for the entire "Wilderness Road: Virginia's Heritage Migration Route".
