4. Title: Dental hygienists; extension of educational and preventive care protocol

Summary: The enrolled bill extends for one year the protocol allowing dental hygienists to provide educational and preventive dental care in the Lenowisco, Cumberland Plateau, and Southside Health Districts, which are designated as Virginia Dental Health Professional Shortage Areas by the Department of Health. The bill also delays the required report until January 1, 2012.
