4. Title: Dentists; sedation and anesthesia permits

5. Summary: The enrolled bill requires dentists, with some specific exemptions, who uses sedation or anesthesia in a dental office to obtain either a conscious/moderate sedation permit or a deep sedation/general anesthesia permit issued by the Board of Dentistry. Also requires the Board of Dentistry to promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this act to be effective within 280 days of its enactment.

7. Fiscal Impact Cannot Be Determined (see item 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: A specific fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time since there is no clear estimate as to the potential demand for permitting. However, the board will develop cost projections for processing applications during the regulatory process and will establish a fee structure sufficient to cover the cost of issuing permits. Any necessary appropriation can be provided to the Department of Health Professions administratively until such time as the Appropriation Act can be amended.
