**4. Title:** Schedule II drugs; identification required in filling prescriptions

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill mandates that a pharmacist, or his agent, require proof of identity at the time of delivery when dispensing any Schedule II drug to an unknown person. Moreover, for any unknown person seeking to fill a Schedule II prescription, the pharmacist, or his agent, must either make a photocopy or electronic copy of such person's identification or record the full name and address of such person. This documentation must be retained by the pharmacists for at least one month.
