**5. Summary:** This bill modifies the entities to which the Department of Forensic Science may release information from the DNA data bank and adds that information may be released to further a prosecution, not just an investigation as under current law.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill will allow the distribution of DNA data bank information to individuals who are not sworn police officers but are authorized persons who have need of this information to further the investigation or prosecution of criminal offenses.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Forensic Science (DFS), state and local police departments, Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), and Commonwealth's Attorneys.
