3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Elections; acquisition of voting equipment by localities.

5. Summary: Allows the purchase of accessible direct recording electronic machines (DREs) from any source to meet legal mandates to provide accessible voting equipment. However, the number of accessible DREs acquired under this subdivision shall not cause the locality's total number of accessible DREs to exceed two times the number of voting sites in the locality. Current law requires these purchases to be made from existing DRE inventories within the Commonwealth.
