Summary:** This bill adds the State Health Commissioner as a consultant to the Secretary of Natural Resources in developing written guidelines for awarding grants from the Water Quality Improvement Fund. This bill also adds the requirement that any guidelines developed must include criteria and financial incentives for water reuse.
