**5. Summary:** The bill amends the definition of 'criminal investigative file' so that the exemption applies to records relating to active or ongoing investigations or prosecutions.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None. The bill no longer excludes the disclosure of criminal records relating to closed investigations or prosecutions, but this is not expected to present a fiscal impact to the Commonwealth. Other changes are merely clarifying in nature.
