**4. Title:** Juvenile work programs.

**5. Summary:** Adds additional members to the committee that reviews agreements with a public or private entity for the operation of a work program for juveniles committed to the Department of Juvenile Justice. In addition, the bill requires the committee to develop and submit to the Department a plan for the establishment of a network of businesses willing to employ juveniles released from the Department's commitment. Also, a provision is added for this act to become effective on July 1, 2012.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact.
