11200127D **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5020** 1 2 Offered April 27, 2011 3 Celebrating the life of Evelyn Momsen Hailey. 4 Patrons-Miller, Y.B. and Marsden 5 6 Unanimous consent to introduce 7 WHEREAS, Evelyn Momsen Hailey, a pioneering advocate for the rights of women and 8 environmental protection as a member of the House of Delegates from 1974 to 1982 and the Virginia 9 10 Senate from 1982 to 1984, died on March 29, 2011; and WHEREAS, a native of Minnesota, Evelyn Hailey was the daughter of Anne Offutt Momsen and Vice Admiral Charles B. Momsen, the inventor of the "Momsen Lung," and lived in numerous places 11 12 around the world during her youth, including Hawaii, where she was a witness to the events of 13 14 December 7, 1941, at Pearl Harbor; and WHEREAS, after her marriage to Captain Robert Hailey in 1943, Evelyn Hailey continued to see the 15 16 world while supporting her husband in his career, raising her family, and participating in community 17 events: and WHEREAS, after settling in the Hampton Roads area, Evelyn Hailey participated in civic life as a 18 19 parent-teacher association leader and volunteer with the League of Women voters and developed an 20 interest in making a difference on the state level; and WHEREAS, a gracious, intelligent, and strong woman, Evelyn Hailey came to the General Assembly 21 in 1974 and became an enthusiastic champion of women's rights, the community college system, 22 23 immunization for schoolchildren, the unifying of ports, and environmental protections; and WHEREAS, Evelyn Hailey served her constituents with great skill and integrity while working with 24 25 other legislators to enact important legislation to improve the quality of life for all residents of the 26 Commonwealth: and 27 WHEREAS, a ground-breaking legislator, Evelyn Hailey became the second woman to represent 28 Norfolk in the General Assembly and the second female state senator in Virginia's history as she 29 continued to be an effective public servant; and 30 WHEREAS, over the course of her distinguished legislative career, Evelyn Hailey epitomized the 31 ideals of a public servant, fulfilling her responsibilities with great integrity, tireless passion, and 32 visionary leadership; and 33 WHEREAS, predeceased by son Robert, Evelyn Hailey will be greatly missed and fondly 34 remembered by her husband, Robert; surviving children, Anne and Christopher, and their families, including six grandchildren and five great-grandchildren; her numerous other family members and friends; colleagues on both sides of the aisle; and the residents of the Commonwealth whom she 35 36 37 faithfully served; now, therefore, be it 38 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 39 mourn the loss of an admired former member, Evelyn Momsen Hailey; and, be it 40 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 41 presentation to the family of Evelyn Momsen Hailey as an expression of the General Assembly's respect 42 for her memory.
