11200220D **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5030** 1 2 Offered June 9, 2011 3 Celebrating the life of the Honorable Roscoe Bolar Stephenson, Jr. 4 Patron—Deeds 5 6 Unanimous consent to introduce 7 WHEREAS, the Honorable Roscoe Bolar Stephenson, Jr., who served the citizens of the 8 Commonwealth with great distinction as a Virginia Supreme Court Justice, died on May 30, 2011; and 9 WHEREAS, a native of Covington, Roscoe Stephenson was a proud member of the U.S. Army during World War II and received a bachelor's degree and law degree from Washington and Lee 10 11 University, where he evidenced the sharp legal mind and respect for the law that would mark his 12 exemplary career; and 13 14 WHEREAS, after graduation, Roscoe Stephenson returned to Covington, practicing law in partnership 15 with his father before serving as the Commonwealth's Attorney for Alleghany County for 12 years, after 16 which he resumed a career in private practice; and WHEREAS, respected for his keen grasp of the law, sound judgment, and impeccable integrity, 17 Roscoe Stephenson was elected as a judge for the 25th Judicial Circuit on July 12, 1973; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Judge Stephenson presided over the Alleghany County Circuit Court with great fairness, 20 wisdom, and compassion, hearing a variety of cases and delivering sound decisions in the interest of 21 equal justice for all; and 22 WHEREAS, in February of 1981, Judge Stephenson was appointed by the General Assembly to the 23 Virginia Supreme Court, becoming the first individual from the Alleghany Highlands to ascend to the 24 state's highest court; and WHEREAS, Justice Stephenson served the Commonwealth as a Justice on the Virginia Supreme 25 26 Court for the next 16 years, making vital contributions to the state's judicial system while rendering 27 decisions on a wide array of subject matter; and 28 WHEREAS, Justice Stephenson retired from active service in 1997, but continued as a Senior Justice 29 until the summer of 2010; and 30 WHEREAS, Justice Stephenson made numerous contributions to his profession through his service as 31 a member of the Virginia State Bar Council, vice president of the Virginia Bar Association, and fellow in the American College of Trial Lawyers; and 32 33 WHEREAS, Justice Stephenson embodied the ideals of intelligence, character, and public service as 34 he brilliantly served the residents of the Commonwealth throughout his life; and 35 WHEREAS, predeceased by his daughter Martha, Justice Stephenson will be fondly remembered and 36 greatly missed by his wife, Jane; surviving children, Roscoe and Thomas and their families; other 37 relatives and friends; and the citizens of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it 38 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 39 note with great sadness the loss of an esteemed jurist, the Honorable Roscoe Bolar Stephenson, Jr.; and, 40 be it 41 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to the family of the Honorable Roscoe Bolar Stephenson, Jr., as an expression of the 42 General Assembly's profound respect for his memory. 43
