CHAPTER 69

An Act to amend and reenact § 29.1-520 of the Code of Virginia, relating to times for training of bear hounds.

Approved March 1, 2012

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 29.1-520 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 29.1-520. Times for hunting.

A. Nonmigratory game birds and game animals may be hunted from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset. Bears may be hunted without capturing or taking ~~from one-half hour before sunrise until four and one-half hours after sunset~~ *from 4:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.* during bear hound training season.

B. Fur-bearing animals and nuisance species of birds and animals may be hunted by day or by night, except that muskrats may be hunted by day only.

C. A violation of this section shall be punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor.
